"A New Melody: Kamal's Transformative Journey with Autism"



Kamal Ale Magar, a boy with autism from Eaurautar VDC, used to roam aimlessly, skip school, and greet people repetitively. The 'Inspire Care' program identified his condition, leading to transfer Kathmandu's to Autism Care Center, where his interest in playing the Madal was discovered. Following the center's recommendation, Kamal received a Madal and was admitted to Samaj Sewa Yuva Sudhar Sang, a school for children with disabilities in Jhapa.

Since then, he has learned to write, maintain hygiene, and no longer greets people repetitively. His Madal skills have improved, and his hyperactivity has reduced.

Kamal's father is grateful for the I2C program, saying, "I think my son has received a new life."
