

Dipesh's Journey of Empowerment



Dipesh Chaudhary's life changed when he came in contact with a Community-Based Rehabilitation Facilitator in Shrawan, 2077 B.S. through the Disability Prevention and Rehabilitation Program (DPRP). During the initial home visit in Morang, Dipesh was found to have an outdated disability card. CBRF assisted him in renewing his card at a disability assessment camp.

Dipesh then joined the Milijuli group in his ward and became a member of a cooperative. Through the DPRP, he received a tricycle in 2079 B.S., enhancing his mobility. Additionally, CBRF coordinated with The Leprosy Mission to provide him with Rs. 30,000 in capital, which he used to expand his small grocery shop.

Previously unemployed, Dipesh now earns about Rs. 1500 daily, contributing to his family. Active in disability advocacy as the secretary of Milijuli Samuha, Dipesh is a happy, optimistic, and enthusiastic community member.
