Bringing back Julie's Joy

Yadav, a little girl Julie Biratnagar-18, was born with Bilateral Knee Genu Valgum. After treatments at multiple Hospital and HRDC Banepa, her condition showed little improvement. At age underwent corrective surgeries on both legs at HRDC. After 45 days of stay and continuous hospital follow-up, Julie received Rs. 25,000 from her municipality for her treatment.



During a Disability Assessment Camp under the DPRP (program), Asfak was identified. A Community-Based Rehabilitation Facilitator (CBRF) visited the family multiple times to counsel them about the benefits of surgery. After much discussion, they agreed to take Asfak for surgical treatment. He underwent successful surgeries on both feet, first on the right foot and then on the left in the period of three months.

Post-surgery, Asfak transitioned from using a bamboo walker to walking independently with modified shoes. With ongoing physiotherapy, he can now walk confidently. Now studying in Class 1 at Janahit Adhabhut School, Asfak's progress fills his family with pride and gratitude for the support they received from this program.
