

# Khurshid's way to popularity



Mohammad Khurshid from Biratnagar-9, has overcome significant challenges. Diagnosed with poliomyelitis at age 10, he underwent surgery and physiotherapy and later he was fitted with calipers and began walking with crutches. Despite his disability, Khurshid completed his secondary education and took IT and graphic design courses.

In 2017, he started creating technology content on YouTube using his mobile phone, but the low video quality and time-consuming process limited his earnings to \$40-\$50 per month. His situation improved dramatically when the Disability Prevention and Rehabilitation program provided him with a DSLR camera. This upgrade allowed him to produce higher-quality content more efficiently, boosting his monthly income to \$100-\$150.

Now, with 628,000 subscribers, Khurshid has earned a 'Silver Play Button' from YouTube. He plans to collaborate with companies to further grow his subscriber base and expand his reach.
