

Lalchand's Brave Steps

Lalchand Rishidev from Budhiganga-2, faced a life-changing accident while working as a daily wage laborer in a factory. He got severe injuries that led to the amputation of both his lower limbs. After three-month long treatment, Lalchand returned home, entirely dependent on his wife and sons for daily activities like dressing and toileting.



His family's income is now largely reliant on half of his previous salary, with his wife supplementing by selling local drinks. During a home visit, the chairperson of the Organization of Persons with Disabilities (OPD), learned about Lalchand's situation and informed him about our Program (DPRP). After a thorough needs assessment by the Palika focal person and Karuna team, he was referred to the Jaipur Rotary Mahaveer Foot Rehabilitation Center where he received a prosthetic fitting and gait training with a walker.

With support from the program, Lalchand now practices walking with his prosthetic foot and walker. Despite the challenges, he is determined to return to work, saying, "I will do my utmost to walk with the prosthetic foot so I can return to my job."
