Sanguine Mr. Sahu

At 70, Mr. Sitaram Sahu Teli of Bhokraha Narsingha faced a major challenge when diabetes led to the amputation of his right leg. Once a farmer dedicated and sole breadwinner, his condition made daily life increasingly difficult. With a diabetic ulcer in his left leg, he struggled even with basic tasks, relying on a stick for mobility. However, a visit from Community-Based Rehabilitation Facilitators (CBRFs) changed his path.





Through the Disability Prevention and Rehabilitation Program (DPRP), he received a crutch and later, a free prosthetic limb from the Jaipur Foot Rehabilitation Center in Birgunj. This new limb allowed him manage a small grocery shop, independence, regain and contribute to his family's livelihood. Grateful for the support, Mr. Teli reflected, "Though I can't farm anymore, with my prosthetic limb, I can easily look after my shop." His story is a testament to resilience and the transformative power of accessible rehabilitation.
