



Anand Kumar Shah, born to Kabita and Shyam Shah of Duhabi-3, Futani Chowk, was diagnosed with clubfoot at birth. Initially, his parents were unaware of available treatment options and declined intervention. However, after multiple home visits and counseling by a Community-Based Rehabilitation Facilitator (CBRF) from the Disability Prevention and Rehabilitation Program (DPRP), they were persuaded to seek help.

Anand was referred to HRDC, Itahari, where he underwent surgery with the support of the DPRP. Following the treatment, his condition improved significantly. Today, Anand can walk and play freely, without the need for any assistance, marking a positive transformation in his life.
