Livelihood in Animal husbandry

This is the story of Mr. Jayaram Tamang from Sandakpur Rural Municipality. He was born into a farmer's family where he grew up working hard in the fields, helping his family grow cash crops like potatoes to manage financial burdens. Despite their difficult background, Jayaram maintained a positive attitude towards farming.



His life changed when he was shot in the right hand by dacoits, leaving his hand deformed and non-functional. Due to lack of proper medical care in his village, he used local medicinal herbs for treatment. When the program (DPRP) started in his municipality, Jayaram got his disability identity card and joined Milijuli group, receiving leadership, business, and vocational training. He found and developed his abilities. With loans from Milijuli group, he bought three cows, that produced 22 liters of milk daily which he supplies to the Dairy Corporation. Jayaram credits DPRP for informing him about his rights as a person with disability, helping him live a more fulfilling life with animal husbandry as his main occupation.
